

FIGURE PAINTING SUPPLY LIST

Every paint manufacturer has their own version of colors. I believe it is important to have the three primary colors plus black and white. So I recommend the following as a basic starting place for color. You can mix a complete variety of colors from these.

GOLDEN ACRYLICS

Primary Yellow
Primary magenta
Primary Cyan
Mars Black
Titanium White
Polymer medium, gloss

Water spritzer
Bucket for water

If you use oils

GAMBLIN OIL PAINTS:

Hansa Yellow medium
Peryline red or quinacridone red
Thalo blue
White
Black or van dyke brown or indigo
Gamblin has a solvent free liquid and gel medium
Please, no turpentine, Damar or other toxic materials.
Gamsol is an odorless thinner that is fine in small amounts.

Pad with 50-100 sheets of Cheap drawing paper or newsprint, 18x24 or so
A couple or few sheets of good paper.
I'll have BFK Rieves, 22x30 available at cost per sheet or bring what you prefer.

2 Gessoed canvasses or other supports, wood or Masonite. As large as you care to manage.

Rags
Brushes - 1/2 inch, 1 inch, 2 inch or larger.
Paint palette
Charcoal
Drawing pencils
Erasure
